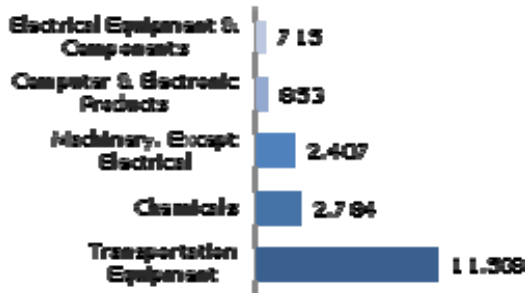

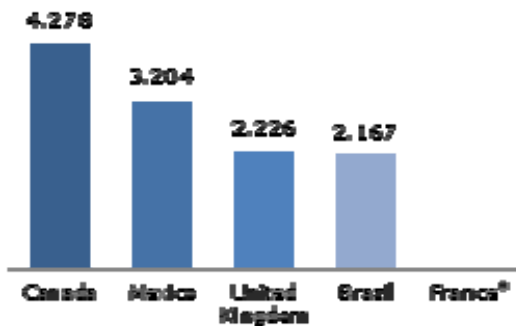

#### Top Export Sectors Millions of dollars



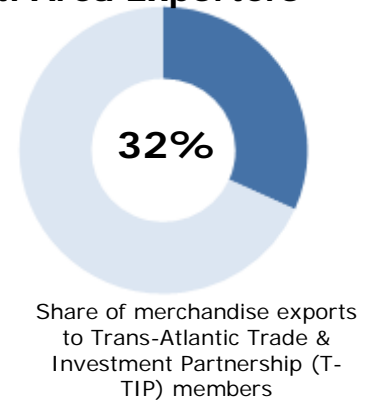
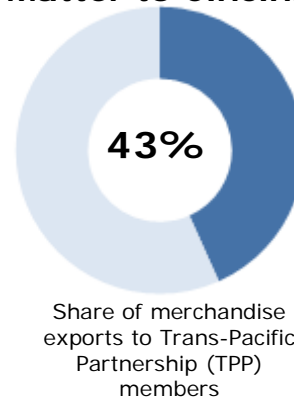
#### Top Export Markets Millions of dollars

#### Current and Future FTAs Matter to Cincinnati Area Exporters



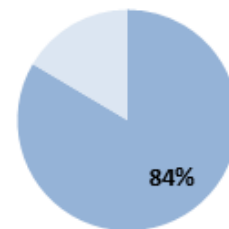

## Cincinnati, OH-KY-IN

- In 2014, Cincinnati was the 14th largest metropolitan area exporter in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$22.3 billion. This is up \$1.3 billion (6.2 percent) from the \$21.0 billion in merchandise exported in 2013.
- In 2012 (latest data available), 3,001 companies exported goods from the Cincinnati metropolitan area. Of these, 2,506 were small- or medium-sized exporters (SMEs) with fewer than 500 employees.
- Counties from the Cincinnati metropolitan area that reported exports in 2014 included: Hamilton County (\$10.5 billion), Kenton County (\$6.9 billion), Boone County (\$2.2 billion), Butler County (\$1.3 billion), Warren County (\$861 million), Clermont County (\$238 million), Campbell County (\$154 million), Dearborn County (\$28 million), Bracken County (\$17 million), Pendleton County (\$12 million).
- In 2014, Cincinnati's top export markets included Canada (\$4.3 billion), Mexico (\$3.2 billion), United Kingdom (\$2.2 billion), Brazil (\$2.2 billion), and France (value suppressed). In addition to these markets, Cincinnati also ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to Italy, Sweden, Norway, and Austria.
- Top export sectors from Cincinnati in 2014 were transportation equipment (\$11.5 billion); chemicals (\$2.8 billion); machinery, except electrical (\$2.4 billion); computer & electronic products (\$853 million); and electrical equipment & components (\$715 million). Cincinnati is also a major metropolitan area exporter of paper; fabricated metal products; miscellaneous manufactures; primary metal manufactures; and plastics and rubber products.
- In 2014, Cincinnati benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting 40.4 percent of merchandise exports to free trade agreement (FTA) partners.
- In 2014, Cincinnati exported \$7.5 billion in goods to the NAFTA region and \$164 million in goods to the CAFTA-DR region.
